



WHAT DOES IT COST ?

Program Fee¹: T.B.A. Please check for future offerings.

The program fee is set by the institution/university offering the course each academic year.

In the past, the program fee has ranged from **\$2,200** to **\$2,500** CAD

The Program Fee **includes** the following:

- ✓ All travel within Colombia, including transportation in Bogotá, flights from Bogotá to Leticia, land and boat transportation in the Amazon.
- ✓ Lodging in Bogotá (bed & breakfast), as well as lodging in Leticia and Calanoa
- ✓ All meals in the Amazon portion (less drinks and snacks)
- ✓ Local instructors, lecturers and guides; entrance fees to museums and local attractions

Not included² in the program fee:

- + International return airfare tickets to Bogotá are not included (estimated ± \$1,000 CAD).
- + Course Tuition is not included in the program fee (check with offering institution).
- + Personal travel insurances.
- + Reciprocity fee charged to Canadian citizens on arrival in Bogotá (estimated ± \$80 CAD).
- + Meals in Bogotá, non-estimated extras, laundry, telephone calls, tips and gratuities as well as personal expenses. Alcoholic drinks and all other drinks and food not included in the itinerary (estimated ± \$300 CAD).
- + Tourism contribution charged by local authorities on arrival to Leticia's airport (± \$10 CAD)
- + Any other expenses before the start of the course or after its ending.
- + Cost of immunization.
- + Passport renewal (Students should make sure passport is current and will be valid for 6 months past your travel date).
- + Any other expenses not mentioned.
